# Serving God Gains Lasting Treasure | 6:19–21

**<sup>19</sup> “Do not store up for yourselves treasures on earth, where moth and rust destroy, and where thieves break in and steal.**

**<sup>20</sup> But store up for yourselves treasures in heaven, where neither moth nor rust destroys, and where thieves do not break in or steal;**

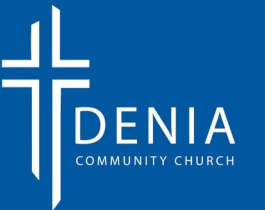
**<sup>21</sup> for where your treasure is, there your heart will be also.**

**<sup>22</sup> “The eye is the lamp of the body; so then if your eye is clear, your whole body will be full of light. <sup>23</sup> But if your eye is bad, your whole body will be full of darkness. If then the light that is in you is darkness, how great is the darkness!**
