(1) Jesus Prioritized Prayer | Mark 1:32–35

³² When evening came, after the sun had set, they began bringing to Him all who were ill and those who were demon-possessed. ³³ And the whole city had gathered at the door. ³⁴ And He healed many who were ill with various diseases, and cast out many demons; and He was not permitting the demons to speak, because they knew who He was. ³⁵ In the early morning, while it was still dark, Jesus got up, left the house, and went away to a secluded place, and was praying there.

(1) Jesus Prioritized Prayer | Mark 14:22-23

Immediately He made the disciples get into the boat and go ahead of Him to the other side, while He sent the crowds away. ²³ After He had sent the crowds away, He went up on the mountain by Himself to pray; and when it was evening, He was there alone.

(1) Jesus Prioritized Prayer | Luke 5:15-16

¹⁵ But the news about Him was spreading even farther, and large crowds were gathering to hear Him and to be healed of their sicknesses. ¹⁶ But Jesus Himself would often slip away to the wilderness and pray.

(2) Jesus Thanked and Praised God

³⁶ He took the seven loaves and the fish; and giving thanks, He broke them and started giving them to the disciples....
(Matthew 15)

²² While they were eating, He took some bread, and after a blessing He broke it, and gave it to them, and said, "Take it; this is My body." ²³ And when He had taken a cup and given thanks, He gave it to them, and they all drank from it.
(Mark 14)

(2) Jesus Thanked and Praised God

¹¹ Jesus then took the loaves, and having given thanks, He distributed to those who were seated... (John 6)

²³ There came other small boats from Tiberias near to the place where they ate the bread after the Lord had given thanks. (John 6)

(2) Jesus Thanked and Praised God

²¹ At that very time He rejoiced greatly in the Holy Spirit, and said, “I praise You, O Father, Lord of heaven and earth, that You have hidden these things from the wise and intelligent and have revealed them to infants. Yes, Father, for this way was well-pleasing in Your sight.” (Luke 10)

²⁸ “Father, glorify Your name.” Then a voice came out of heaven: “I have both glorified it, and will glorify it again.” (John 12)



(3) Jesus Prayed for Others

³¹ “Simon, Simon, behold, Satan has demanded permission to sift you like wheat; ³² but I have prayed for you, that your faith may not fail; and you, when once you have turned again, strengthen your brothers.” (Luke 22)

¹⁶ “I will ask the Father, and He will give you another Helper, that He may be with you forever; ¹⁷ that is the Spirit of truth,…” (John 14)

(3) Jesus Prayed for Others

⁹ “I ask on their behalf;... (John 17)

²⁰ “I do not ask on behalf of these alone....” (John 17)

³⁴ “Father, forgive them; for they do not know what they are doing.” (Luke 23)

Jesus Cleansed the Temple | Mark 11:15–17

¹⁵ Then they came to Jerusalem. And He entered the temple and began to drive out those who were buying and selling in the temple, and overturned the tables of the money changers and the seats of those who were selling doves; ¹⁶ and He would not permit anyone to carry merchandise through the temple. ¹⁷ And He began to teach and say to them, “Is it not written, ‘My house shall be called a house of prayer for all the nations’ [Isaiah 56:7]? But you have made it a robbers’ den [Jeremiah 7:11].



God Reassures Gentile Converts | Isaiah 56:3–5

³ Let not the foreigner who has joined himself to the Lord say, “The Lord will surely separate me from His people.” Nor let the eunuch say, “Behold, I am a dry tree.” ⁴ For thus says the Lord, “To the eunuchs who keep My sabbaths, and choose what pleases Me, and hold fast My covenant, ⁵ to them I will give in My house and within My walls a memorial, and a name better than that of sons and daughters; I will give them an everlasting name which will not be cut off.

God Reassures Gentile Converts | Isaiah 56:6–5

⁶ “Also the foreigners who join themselves to the LORD, to minister to Him, and to love the name of the LORD, to be His servants, every one who keeps from profaning the sabbath and holds fast My covenant; ⁷ even those I will bring to My holy mountain and make them joyful in My house of prayer. Their burnt offerings and their sacrifices will be acceptable on My altar; for My house will be called a house of prayer for all the peoples.” ⁸ The Lord GOD, who gathers the dispersed of Israel, declares, “yet others I will gather to them, to those already gathered.”

(4) Jesus Prayed in Crucial Moments | Jesus' Baptism

²¹ Now when all the people were baptized, Jesus was also baptized, and while He was praying, heaven was opened,
²² and the Holy Spirit descended upon Him in bodily form like a dove, and a voice came out of heaven, "You are My beloved Son, in You I am well-pleased." (Luke 3)

(4) Jesus Prayed in Crucial Moments | Choosing The Twelve

¹² It was at this time that He went off to the mountain to pray, and He spent the whole night in prayer to God. ¹³ And when day came, He called His disciples to Him and chose twelve of them, whom He also named as apostles. (Luke 6)

(4) Jesus Prayed in Crucial Moments | Peter's Confession

9.18 It happened that while He was praying alone, the disciples were with Him, and He questioned them, saying, "Who do the people say that I am?" ... ²⁰ And He said to them, "But who do you say that I am?" And Peter answered and said, "The Christ of God." (Luke 9)

(4) Jesus Prayed in Crucial Moments | Jesus' Transfiguration

²⁸ He took along Peter and John and James, and went up on the mountain to pray. ²⁹ And while He was praying, the appearance of His face became different, and His clothing became white and gleaming. (Luke 9)

(4) Jesus Prayed in Crucial Moments | Gethsemane

⁴¹ He withdrew from them about a stone's throw, and He knelt down and began to pray, ⁴² saying, "Father, if You are willing, remove this cup from Me; yet not My will, but Yours be done." ⁴³ Now an angel from heaven appeared to Him, strengthening Him. ⁴⁴ And being in agony He was praying very fervently; and His sweat became like drops of blood, falling down upon the ground. (Luke 22)

(4) Jesus Prayed in Crucial Moments | Golgotha

At the ninth hour Jesus cried out with a loud voice, “Eloi, Eloi, lama sabachthani?” which is translated, “My God, My God, why have You forsaken Me? [Psalm 22:1]” (Mark 15:34)

⁴⁴ It was now about the sixth hour, and darkness fell over the whole land until the ninth hour, ⁴⁵ because the sun was obscured; and the veil of the temple was torn in two. ⁴⁶ and Jesus, crying out w/ a loud voice, said, “Father, into Your hands I commit My spirit” [Psalm 31:5] Having said this, He breathed His last. (Luke 22)

(5) Jesus Prayed Deferring to God's Will

12.27 “ ‘Now My soul has become troubled; and what shall I say, ‘Father, save Me from this hour’? But for this purpose I came to this hour. ²⁸ Father, glorify Your name.” (John 12)

⁵³ Or do you think that I cannot appeal to My Father, and He will at once put at My disposal more than twelve legions of angels? (Matthew 26)

(5) Jesus Prayed Deferring to God's Will

³⁹ He ... fell on His face and prayed, saying, "My Father, if it is possible, let this cup pass from Me; yet not as I will, but as You will." ... ⁴² He went away again a second time and prayed, saying, "My Father, if this cannot pass away unless I drink it, Your will be done."

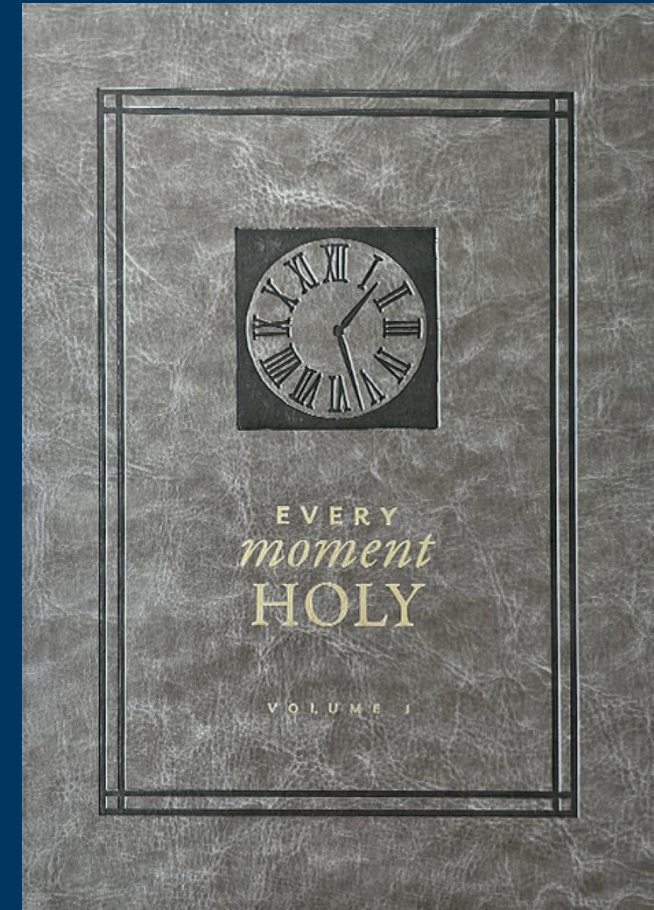
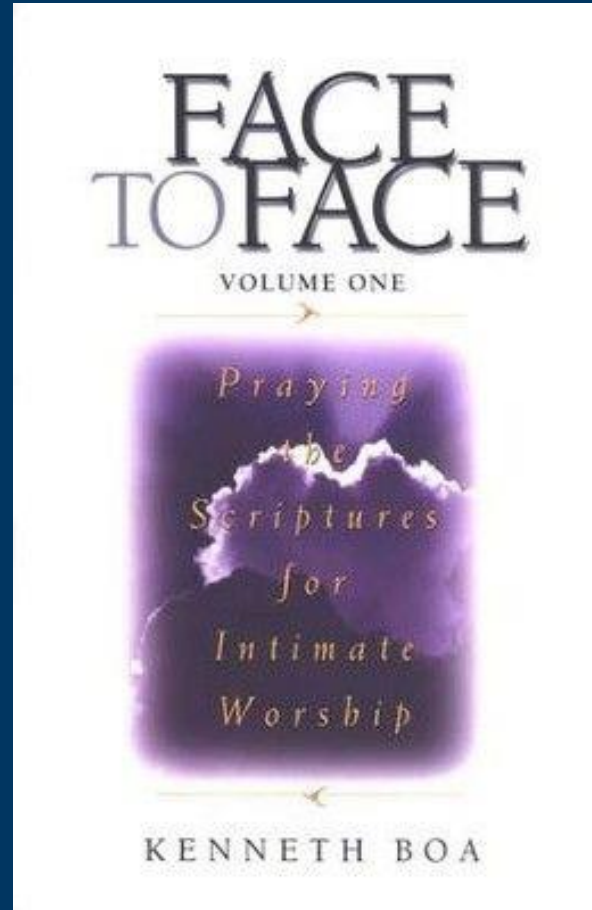
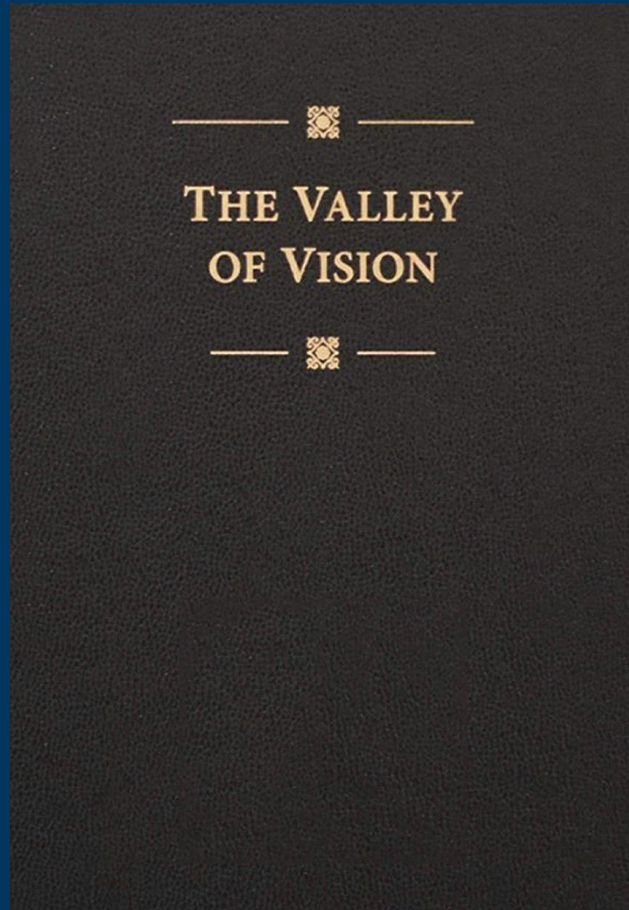
