# Census of Exodus Adults | Numbers 1

<sup>1</sup> Then the LORD spoke to Moses in the wilderness of Sinai, in the tent of meeting, on the first of the second month, in the second year after they had come out of the land of Egypt, saying, <sup>2</sup> “Take a census of all the congregation of the sons of Israel, by their families, by their fathers’ households, according to the number of names, every male, head by head <sup>3</sup> from twenty years old and upward, whoever is able to go out to war in Israel, you and Aaron shall number them by their armies.

# Census of Exodus Adults | Numbers 1

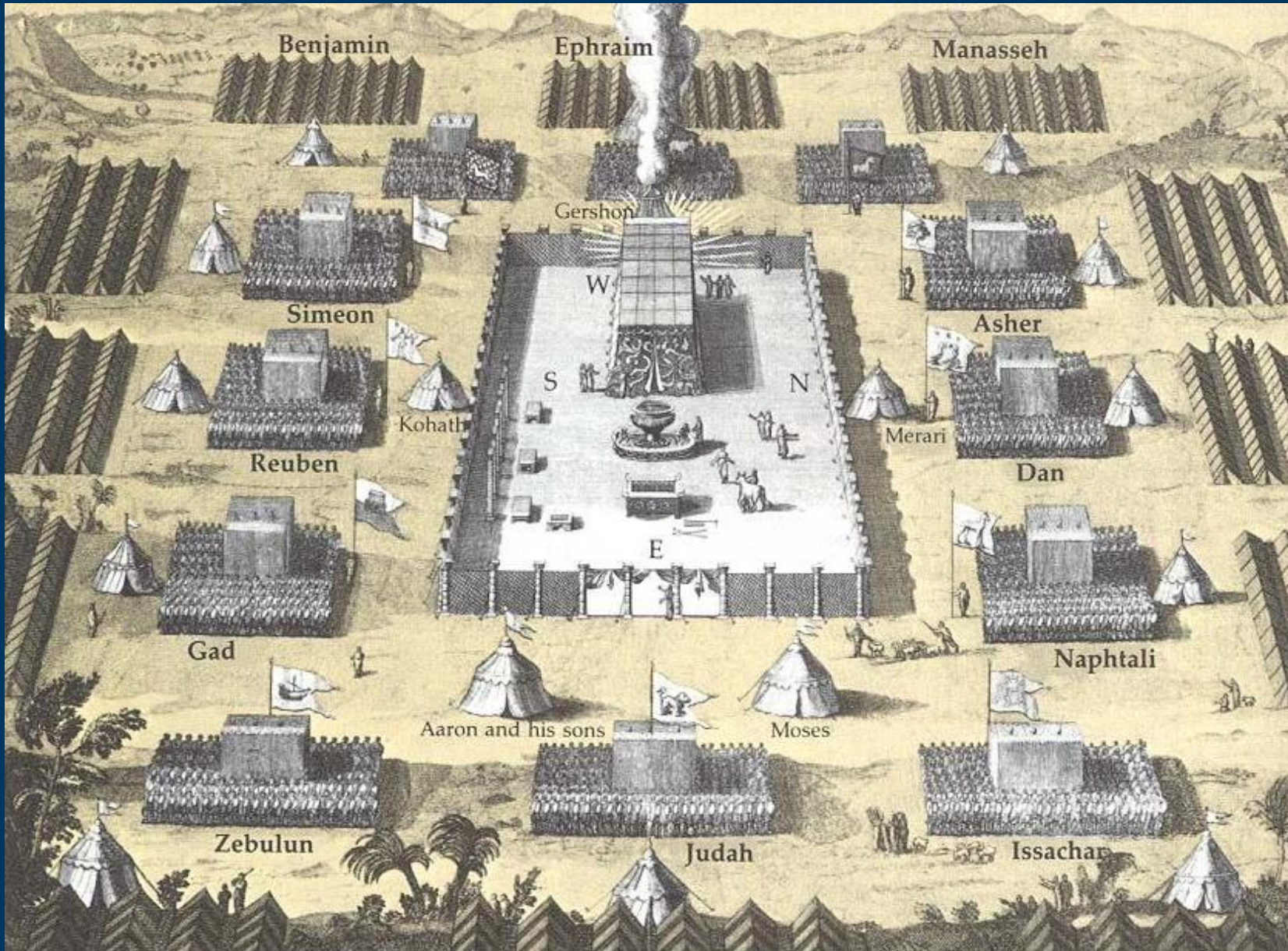
<sup>45</sup> So all the numbered men of the sons of Israel by their fathers' households, from twenty years old and upward, whoever was able to go out to war in Israel, <sup>46</sup> even all the numbered men were 603,550.

# Camping and Decamping Instructions | Numbers 2

<sup>1</sup> Now the LORD spoke to Moses and to Aaron, saying, <sup>2</sup> “The sons of Israel shall camp, each by his own standard, with the banners of their fathers’ households; they shall camp around the tent of meeting at a distance.

<sup>34</sup> Thus the sons of Israel did; according to all that the LORD commanded Moses, so they camped by their standards, and so they set out, everyone by his family according to his father’s household.

# The Aaronic Blessing | Numbers 6

**22** Then the LORD spoke to Moses, saying, **23** “Speak to Aaron and to his sons, saying, ‘Thus you shall bless the sons of Israel. You shall say to them:

**25** The LORD make His face shine on you, and be gracious to you;

**26** The LORD lift up His countenance on you, and give you peace.’

**27** “So they shall invoke My name on the sons of Israel, and I then will bless them.”
